

4. Titus 2:1-5

... *Teach!*

Thomas Boston looked over his life and said: *"I bless the Lord, who gave me counsel then and afterwards, to seek and value conversation with serious Christians, in the places where my lot was cast."*

A little error is a terrible thing (v.1)

Verse 1: "You must teach what is in accord with sound doctrine."

*Your word is a lamp to my feet
and a light to my path.*

God's Word is clear, true, sufficient and necessary.

Older men: Knowing Christ, you have a task to become this (v.2)

What do you want to be when you grow up?

Teach the older men to be;

Temperate (or sober-minded);

Worthy of respect;

Self-controlled;

Sound in faith;

Sound in love;

Sound in endurance.

Older women: Knowing Christ, you have a task too (v.3-4)

Teach the older women to be;

Reverent in the way they live;
Not slanderers;
Not addicted to much wine;
To teach what is good;
To train the younger women to love their husbands and
children;
To be self-controlled and pure
To be busy at home
to be kind
To be subject to their husbands.

Set before us the honour of God (v.5)

**“I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who
live, but Christ who lives in me.”**

What God calls us to be, He supplies the
strength for, and so let us ask to become a man or
woman of Titus 2.
